



NOTICE OF RACE

TRISKELLCUP 2009 Live-on-boards and Beach Catamarans

Name of the event: TRISKELLCUP 2009

Dates: From October, 30 till November, 1 - 2009

Location : Petit Cul de Sac Marin and Gosier Bay

Organiser : LE TRISKELL

1. RULES

The TRISKELLCUP 2009 is an official race of the French Sailing association organized in GUADELOUPE by LE TRISKELL association. This race counts for 2010 Guadeloupe Cup for live-on-boards and beach cats and ruled by the Guadeloupean Sailing League. The regatta is governed by:

- 1.1. Rules which are defined by the racing rules of sailing.
- 1.2. The national prescriptions applying to foreign participants are specified in the appendix.
- 1.3. The federal championship and national rules when they apply.
- 1.4. The Part B, section II of the RIPAM (IRPCAS) when they replace the chapter 2 of the racing instructions.
- 1.5. The Caribbean Sailing Association (C.S.A) rules.
- 1.6. The present race announcement, the live on board instructions and their appendix.
- 1.7. In case of translation of this announcement the French text will prevail.

2. ADVERTISING

In application of the regulation 20 of the ISAF (Advertising code) modified by the FFV (Fédération Française de Voile) rules, boats may be required to display advertising provided by the organizing authority.

3. ENTRY AND REGISTRATION

- 3.1.1. The regatta is open for registration to any boat complying with their national authority with CE marking or boats built before the marking with a certification for coastal cruising.
- 3.2. The regatta is open to boats racing under the French HN handicap, CSA, MK2000 and the beach catamarans rules as long as adequate safety measures are taken.
- 3.3. Boats can register on the following website : www.triskellcup.com
- 3.4. Competitors (each crew member) French resident must show upon registration:
 - Their FFV valid sailing certificate wearing the medical stamp and for minors, parents' authorization.
 - If necessary, the upgrading certificate duly filled.
 - Authorization for display of advertising.
 - Rating certificate or conformity certificate.

Foreign competitors without an FFV certificate must justify their affiliation to a national authority, member of the ISAF.

2. CLASS 8 AND SURPRISES (CSA)
3. SPINNAKER 1 (CSA)
4. SPINNAKER 2 (CSA)
5. CRUISING (CSA)
6. MULTIHULLS (MULTI 2000)
7. BEACH CATAMARANS

4. FEES

50 per crew member for the whole event, including finger food buffet on Friday and Saturday evening meal and show.

20 for the Saturday night dinner, for visitors and friends who do not compete.

5. PROGRAM

5.1. Confirmation of Registration at the Marina Yacht Club: on October Sunday 25 and Monday 26, 2009 from 3 p.m. Participants coming from outside Guadeloupe can register till October 29 before 6 p.m.

5.2. RACING DAYS

Thursday, October 29th briefing at 7 p.m

Friday, October 30 th start at 10 a.m

Saturday, October 31st start at 10 a.m

Sunday, November 1st first start at 9 a.m

6. RACING INSTRUCTIONS

According to the FFV regulations, the racing instructions will be posted upon registration opening and appendixes will be given to the competitors when confirming the registration.

7. COURSES

All races will be coastal courses.

8. PENALTY SYSTEM

8.1. For classes racing under the 44.1 rule the 720° penalty is replaced by the 360° penalty.

8.2. Replacement penalties for infractions to rules others than those under chapter 2 :

One infraction to rules other than chapter 2 and rules 28 and 31 can, after instruction, reach 10% of the disqualification time.

9. RESULTS

9.1. Event results validation by FFV requires 3 races.

9.2. Application of handicaps will be made on a time-on-time system.

9.3. The Low Point scoring system will apply.

9.4. Provisional results will be displayed each evening

10. RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in case of emergency, boats must not transmit or receive radio communications which are not receivable by all boats, while racing. This restriction also applies to mobile phones. All boats must have a VHF radio working on board.

11. PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded on Monday November, 1st at 6 p.m

12. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate at their own risk, decision to race or to keep racing in theirs.

The organization authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.

13. INSURANCE

- a. Foreign competitors without an F.F.V. certificate must provide a liability insurance which covers up to 1.5 million Euros.
